


## Advertisement for Constituency Profiler

### TOR CONSTITUENCY ANALYSIS, ASSAM

<b>Context</b>	<p>The seven aspirational districts are among the most disadvantaged districts in Assam, given the socio-economic parameters as highlighted through various composite index computed by NITI Aayog. While there has been disaggregated analysis of administrative (department's MIS)/ other data sets that have informed policy and programme actions. However, it is largely done keeping in mind the administrative units such as block and districts.</p> <p>However, it is equally pertinent that Elected Representatives are sensitized on the low-performing socio-economic parameters in their constituency so that they are empowered to play an important role in supporting the desired improvements.</p> <p>It is with this backdrop that it is proposed to develop constituency-wise profiles of aspirational districts in the state. The developed profiles would be used to further engagement with the members of legislative assembly to discuss issues related to key socio-economic indicators as well as population groups that require more focused attention.</p> <p>The constituency profiles (having both quantitative and qualitative evidence) would serve as the basis for facilitating this dialogue. In addition, for instance the work on child and gender budgeting could be further strengthened using constituency profiles which will aid in identifying geographic pockets/ social groups and individuals where additional resources needs to be invested. These profiles will also be used as evidence to influence the annual planning and budgeting exercises carried out by the Gram Panchayats (referred as Gram Panchayat Development Planning) and give us a direction of how to facilitate prioritizing agenda on children at the meetings at the Gram Panchayat levels.</p>
<b>What needs to be done</b>	Disaggregated analysis of administrative (MIS) data available through secondary sources and development of case studies to capture multiple deprivations being faced by specific communities/ individuals. The evidence will be generated for the political constituencies which has not been attempted in the past.
